### **Introduction: Print & Digital References**

### We can use **print and digital glossaries** to determine the meaning of words and phrases.

### Print and digital glossaries and dictionaries provide the information needed to understand the *meaning* of words.

It is important to remember that when using a print dictionary, guide words can help you find the word you are looking for.

Guide words are the two words found at the top of a dictionary page.

# Let's look at the entry for the following vocabulary word:

### crumbling

# **crumbling** (adj.): slowly falling apart, usually by breaking into small pieces

This entry provides the definition of the word and the part of speech. By reading the definition of **crumbling**, we are able to understand the meaning and ways to use it correctly.

By reading the definition we can understand how to use the word in a sentence.

Examples of sentences:

The walls of the old building were **crumbling**.

I don't like it when my cookies start **crumbling**.

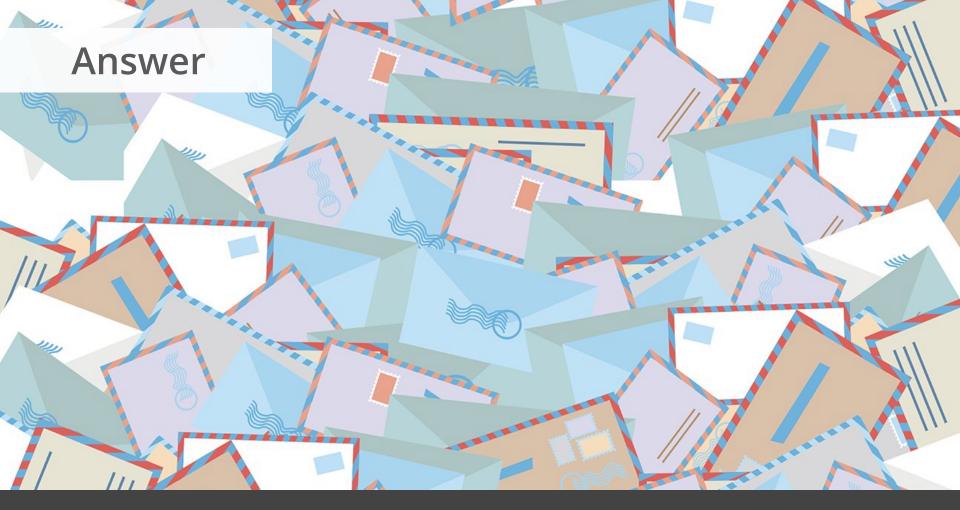


#### Read the following entry:
