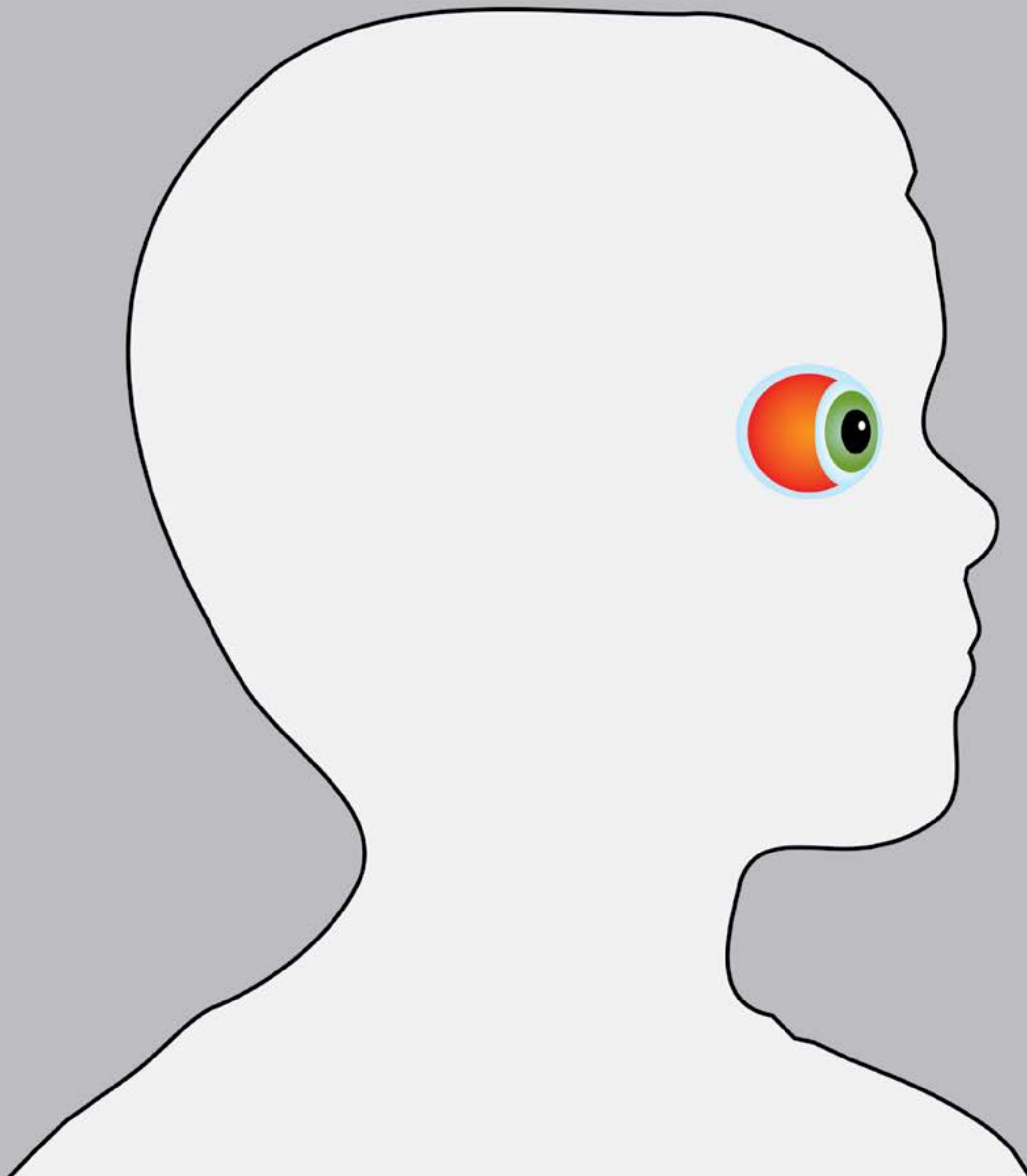
Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the flip book in order to see the images clearly.





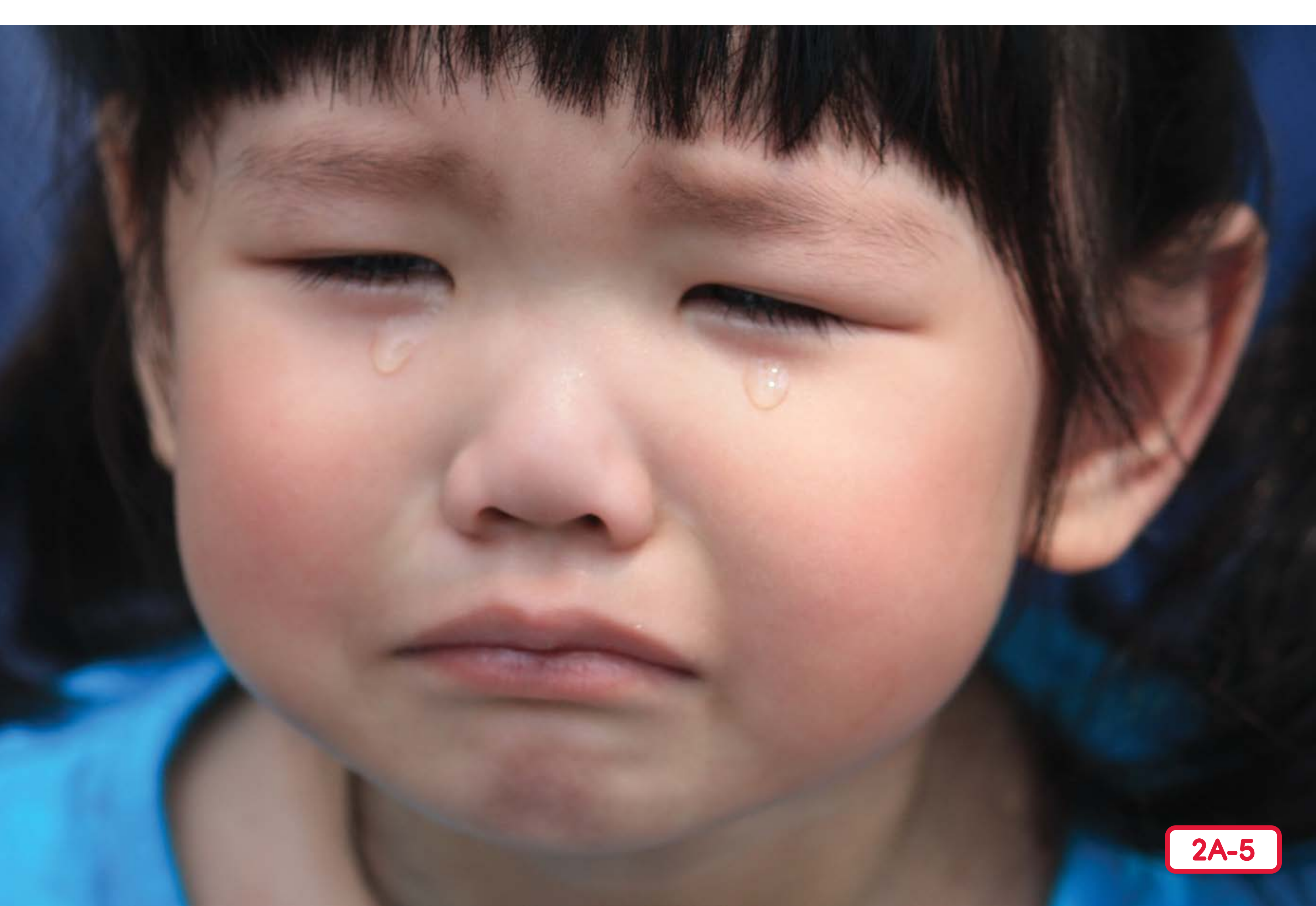

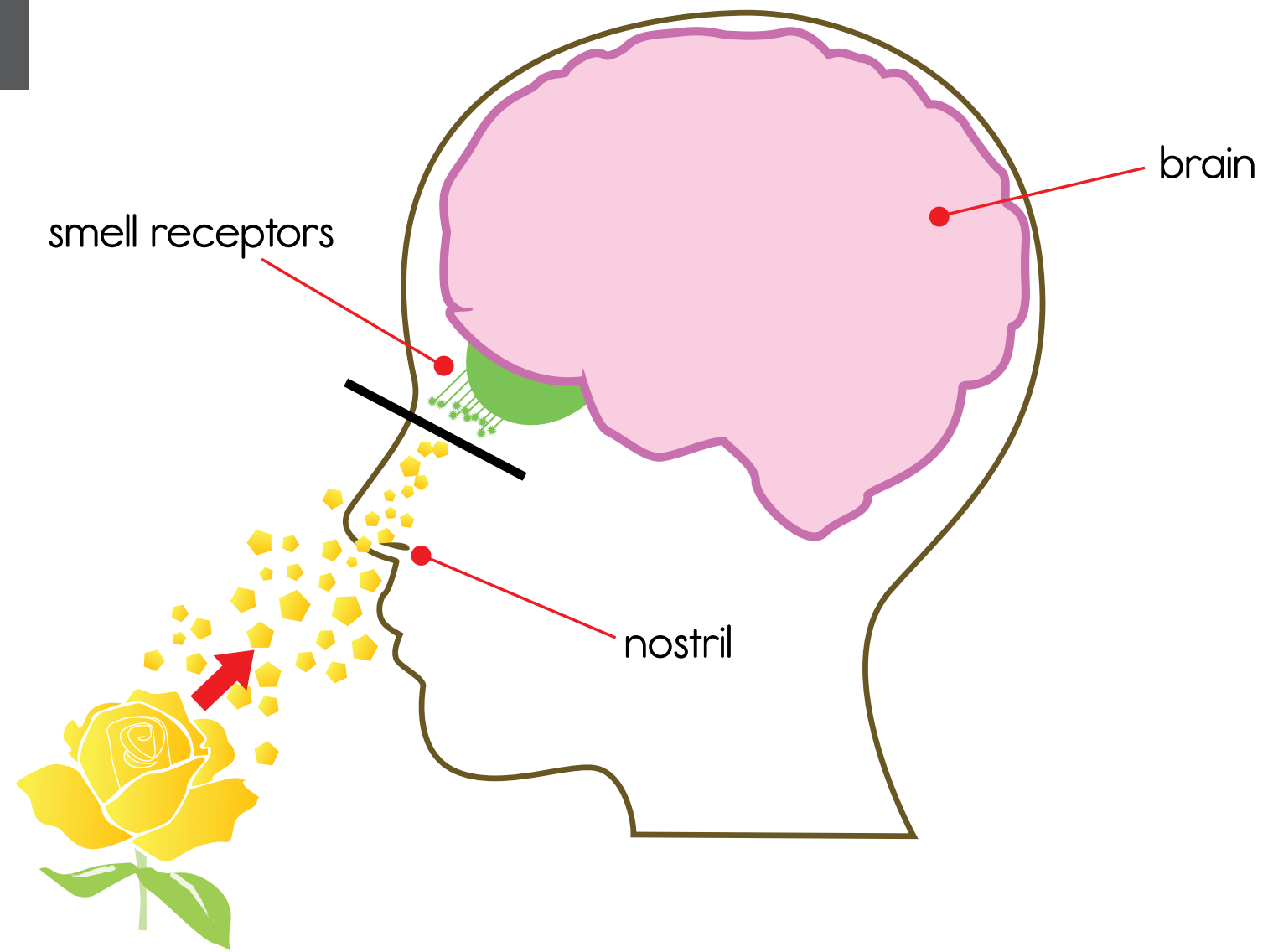




wave (Poster 2M)

4. widespread unusual temperature (*noun*)

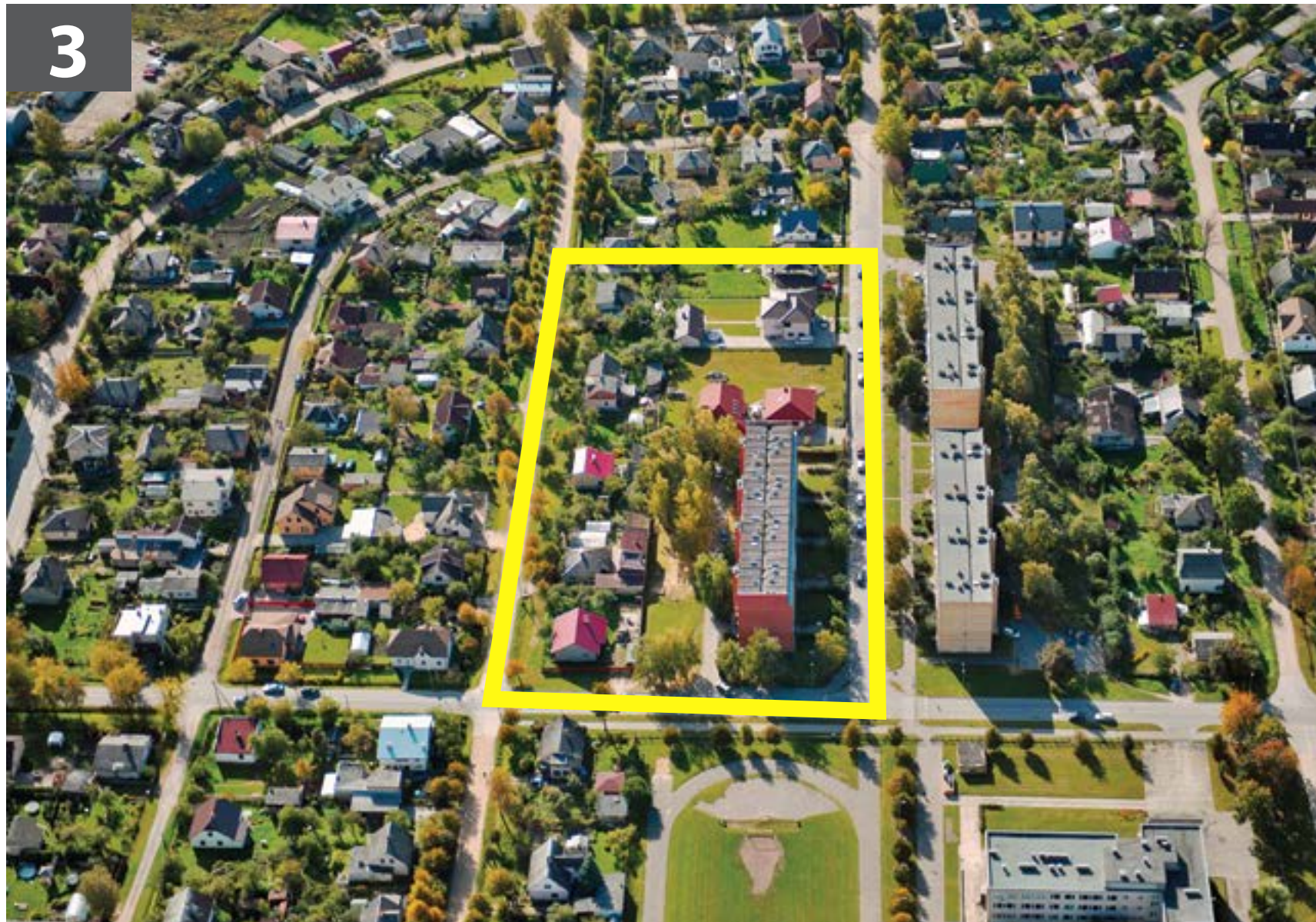

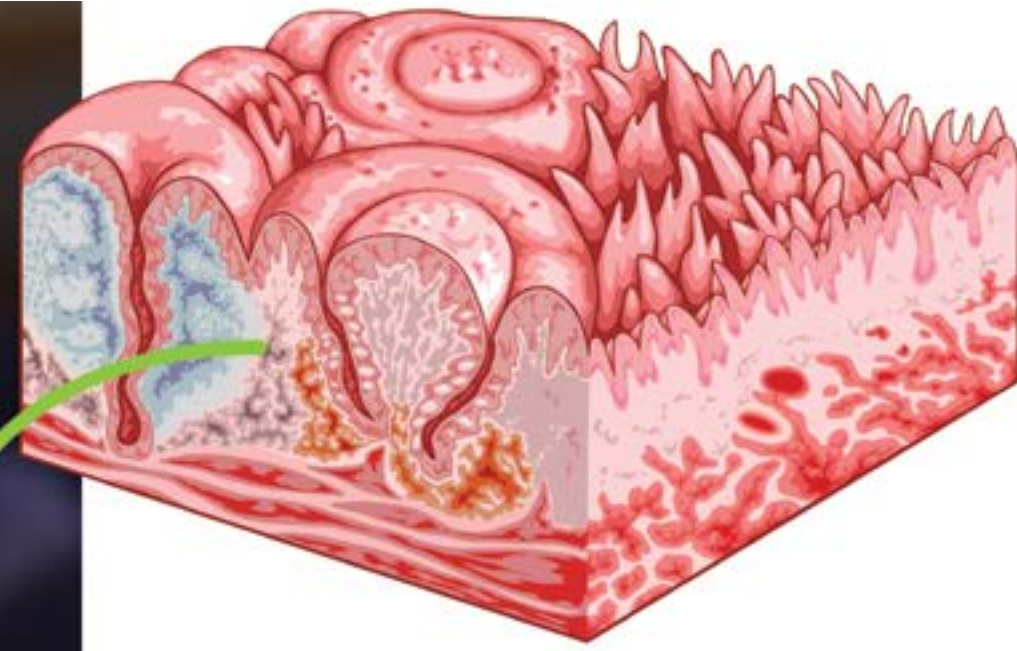

block (Poster 3M)

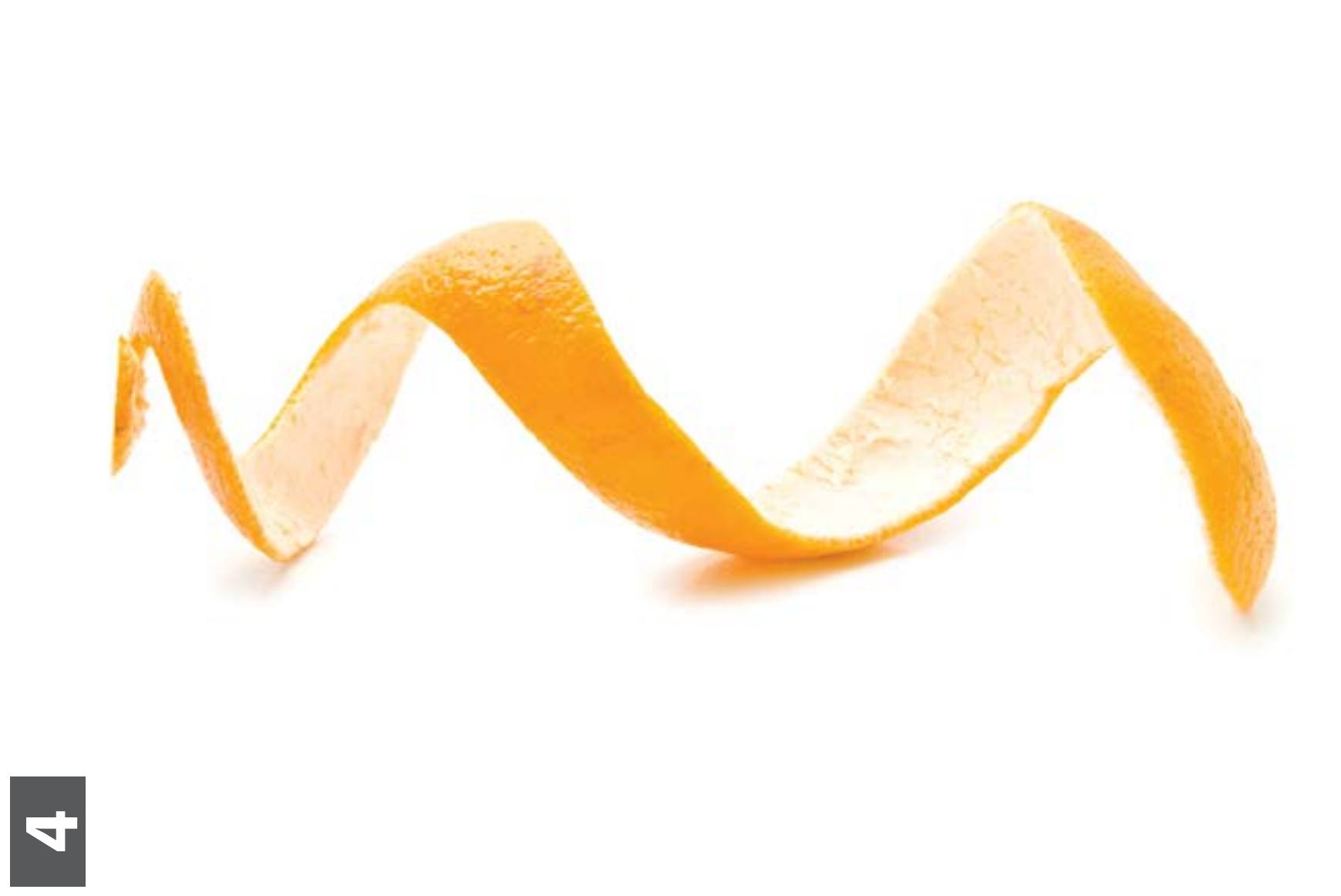
1. to obstruct a passage (*verb*)
