# Grade 4, Unit 2 Knights and Castles: Europe's Middle Ages

In this unit, students will learn about the Middle Ages in Europe.

#### What's the story?

Students will explore Europe's medieval history and will analyze the impact it has had on the modern world.

#### What will my student learn?

Students will continue to build their **background knowledge** to help them **comprehend** the variety of complex texts they will be reading. They will also engage in **deep conversations** with their peers to further develop their understanding of the world around them.

Students will have numerous **writing** opportunities throughout this unit. They will **review the stages of the writing process** by taking notes on the information presented in their Reader. They will use this information to write an informative paragraph that compares two social classes, or groups, from medieval Europe.

#### **Conversation starters**

Ask your student questions about the unit to promote discussion and continued learning:

- What is the Middle Ages?
   Follow up: Why is it called that?
- 2. What do you think were some of the positive things about living in towns during the Middle Ages?
  - **Follow up:** What were some negative things?
- 3. You learned about the word *rival* (i.e., competing). Can you tell me what *rival* means by using it in a sentence?
  - **Follow up:** What is an antonym (opposite meaning) of *rival*? And a synonym (same meaning)?
- 4. How did an aspiring knight prepare for knighthood? **Follow up:** What do you think would have been the hardest thing about the preparation?
- 5. What type of craftsmen existed in the Middle Ages? **Follow up:** What type of craftsman would you have wanted to be?
