 **Ask:** "What do you notice? What do you wonder?"

It's up to Mr. Romero's class to find him.

With their pencils and their notebooks, the students search for clues.

"Look at this!" Sara cries. "I found a chewed-up crayon!"

"And here! I found two more," answers Charlie.

Is this a clue? What would a hamster want with a crayon?

Maybe Harry wants to write a message.

Together, Mr. Romero's class heads to the library to search for more clues.

"Look at this!" Dez cries. "I found three little seeds by the printer."

"And here! Here's another three by the bin," says Lizzy.

Are *these* clues? What would a hamster want with tiny seeds?

Maybe Harry is hungry and wants a tasty snack.

Together, Mr. Romero's class heads to the cafeteria to search for more clues.

"Look at this!" Skye cries. "Six red apples with little hamster bites!"

"And here! Bite marks on these two green ones too!" says Brandon.

But what would a hamster do after a tasty snack?
