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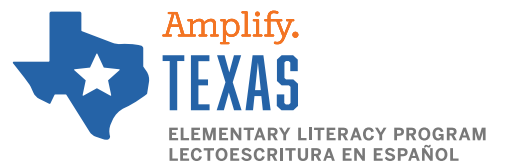
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## **Flip Book Introduction**

Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the flip book in order to see the images clearly.







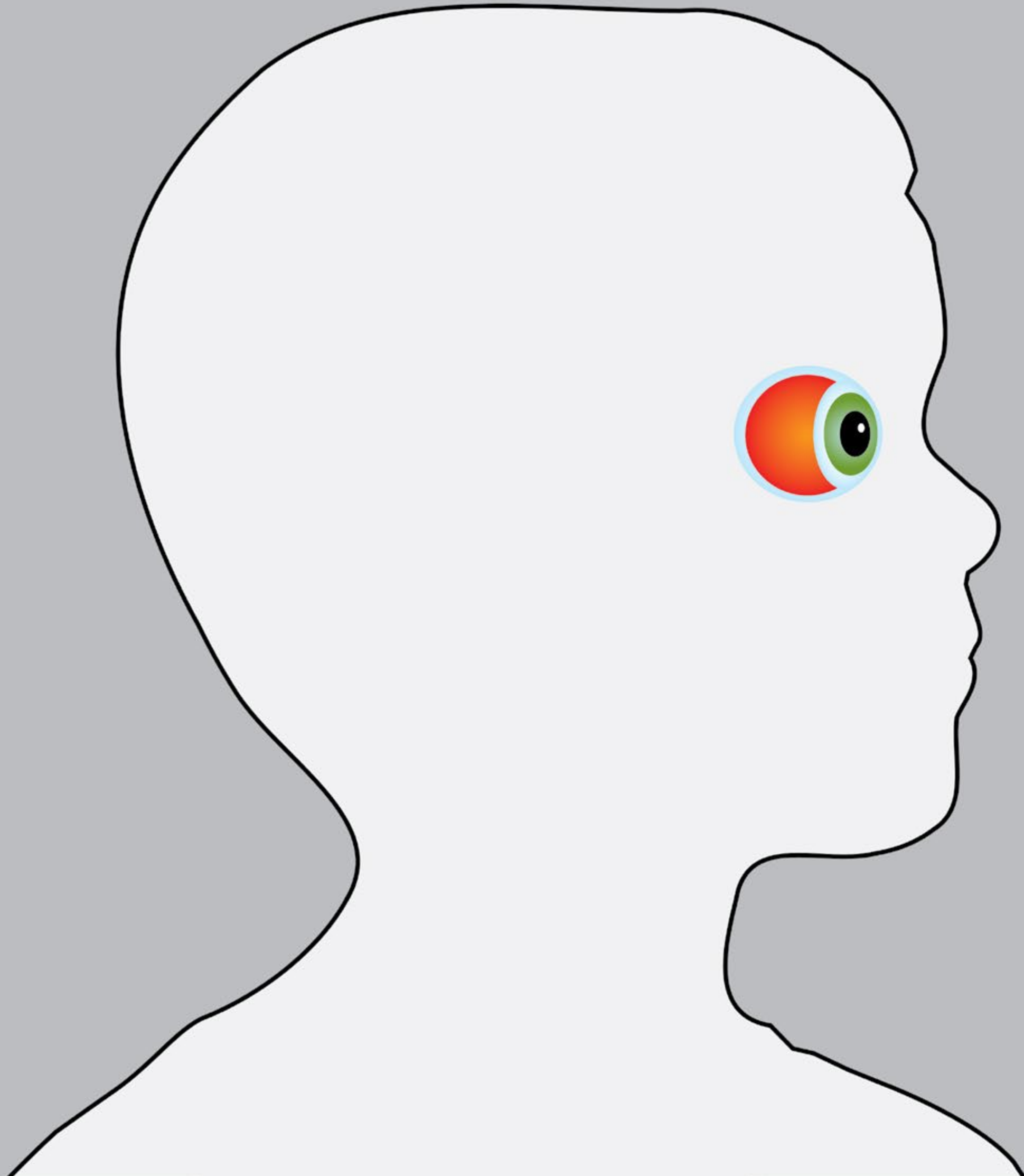

2. a school-aged child (*noun*)



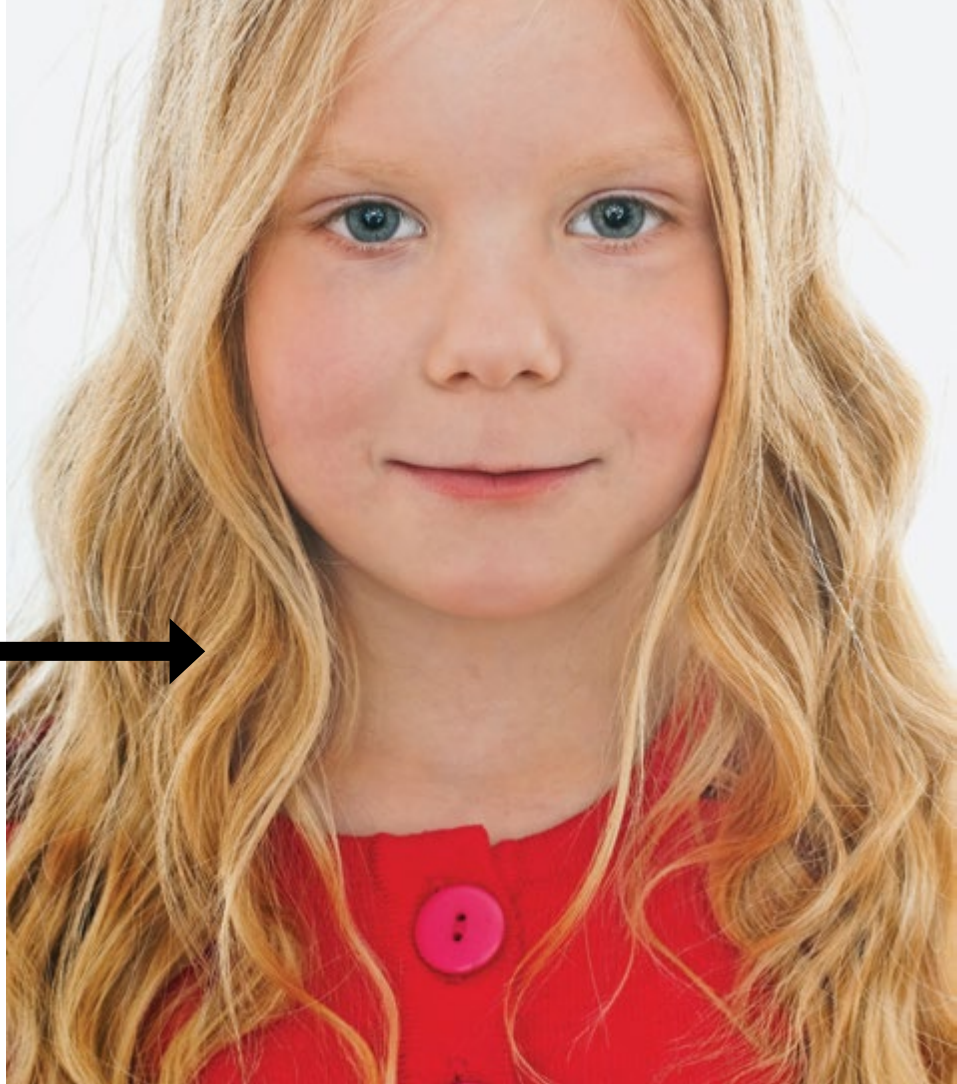

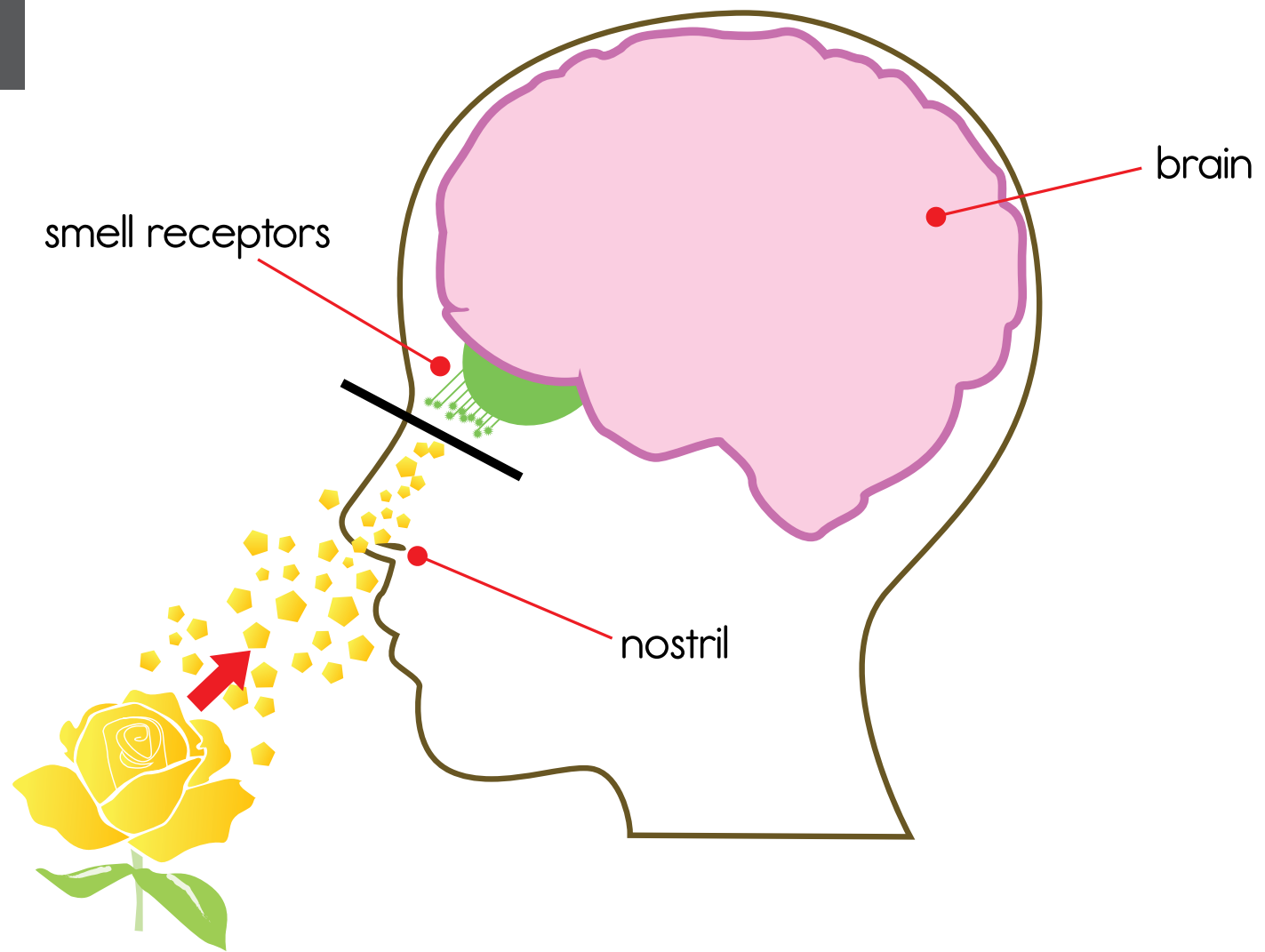


## **wave** (Poster 2M)

4. widespread unusual temperature (*noun*)



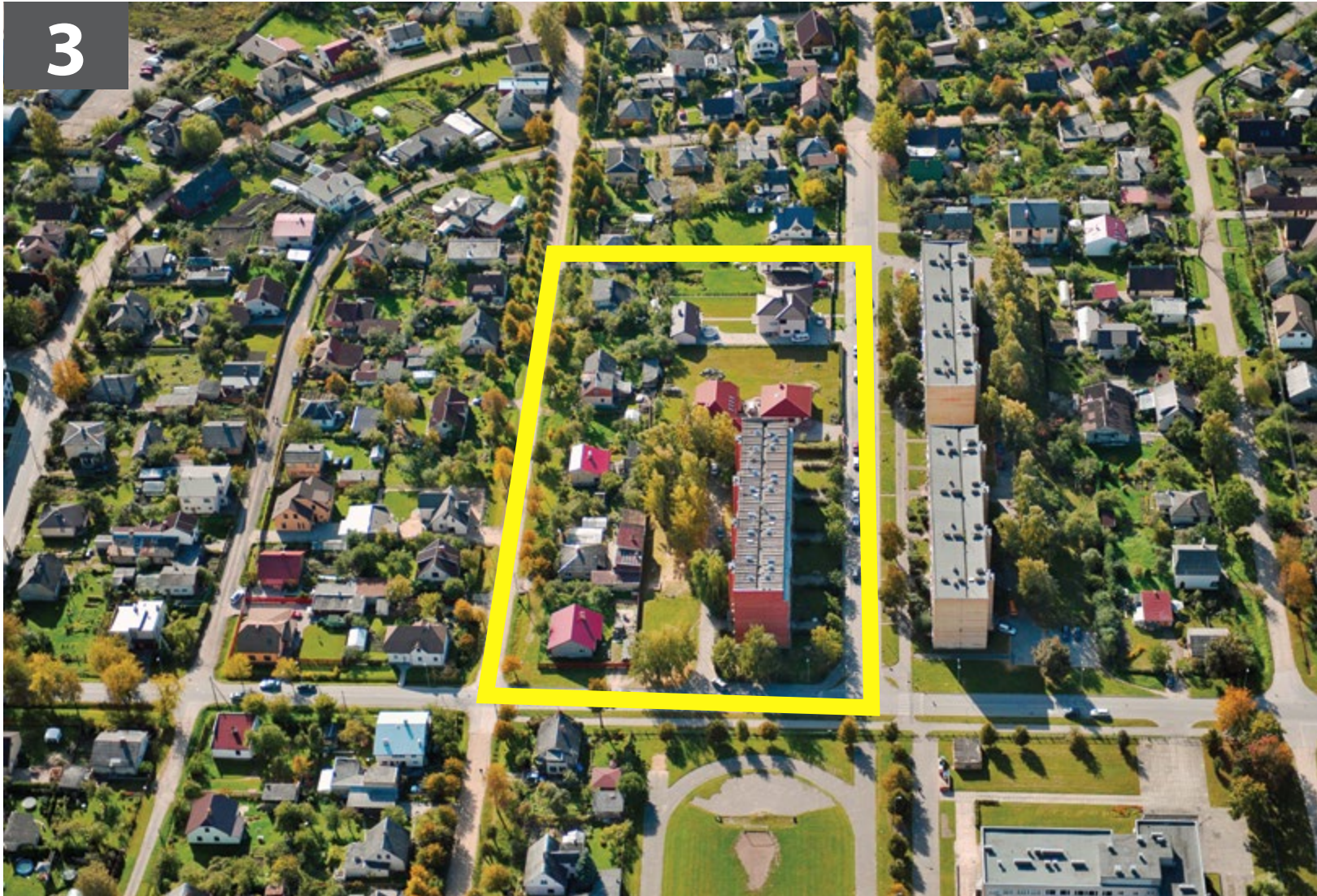

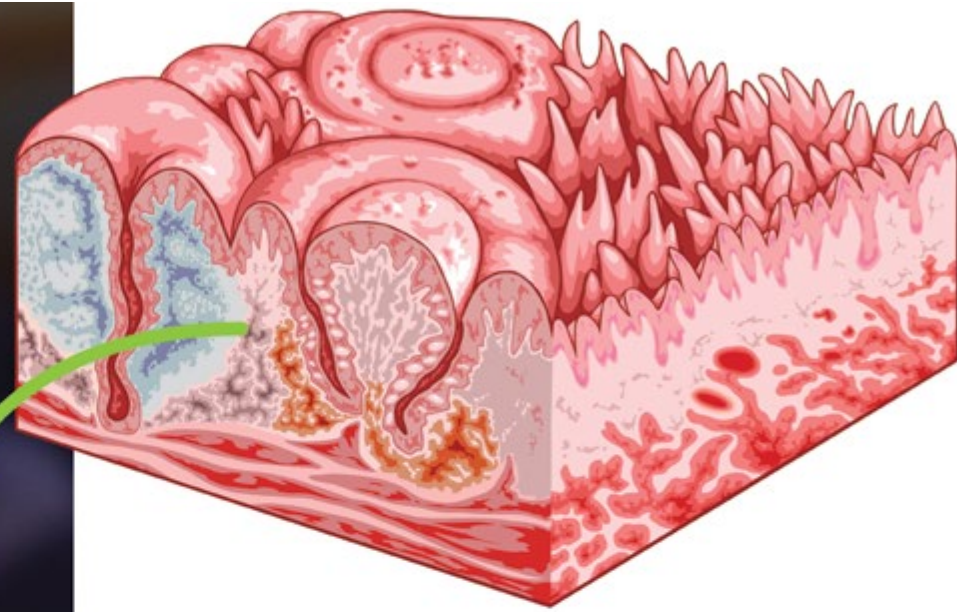




## **block** (Poster 3M)

# **bump** (Poster 4M)

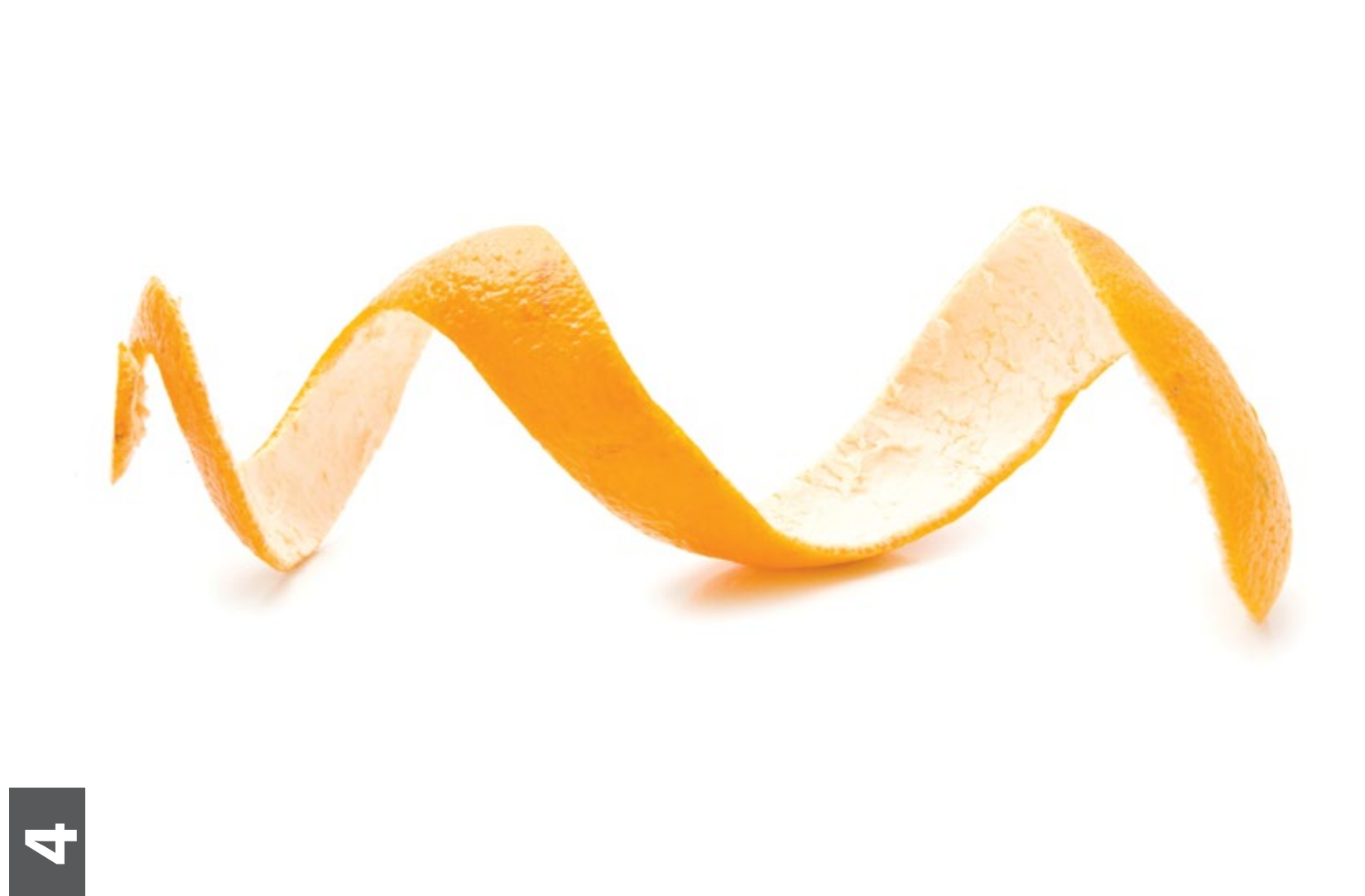
1. something that bulges out (*noun*)

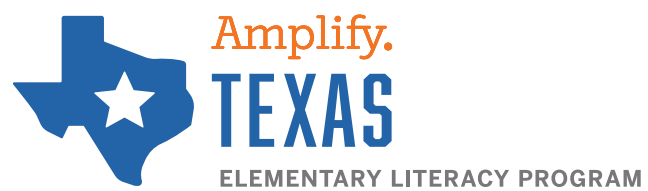




# skin (Poster 5M)
