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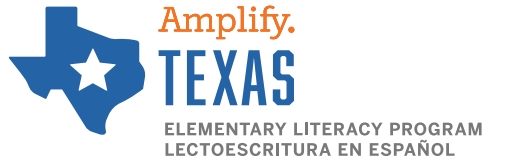
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## **Introducción al Rotafolio de imágenes**

Según la disposición de su salón de clase, puede que sea necesario que los estudiantes se sienten más cerca del Rotafolio para ver las imágenes más claramente.

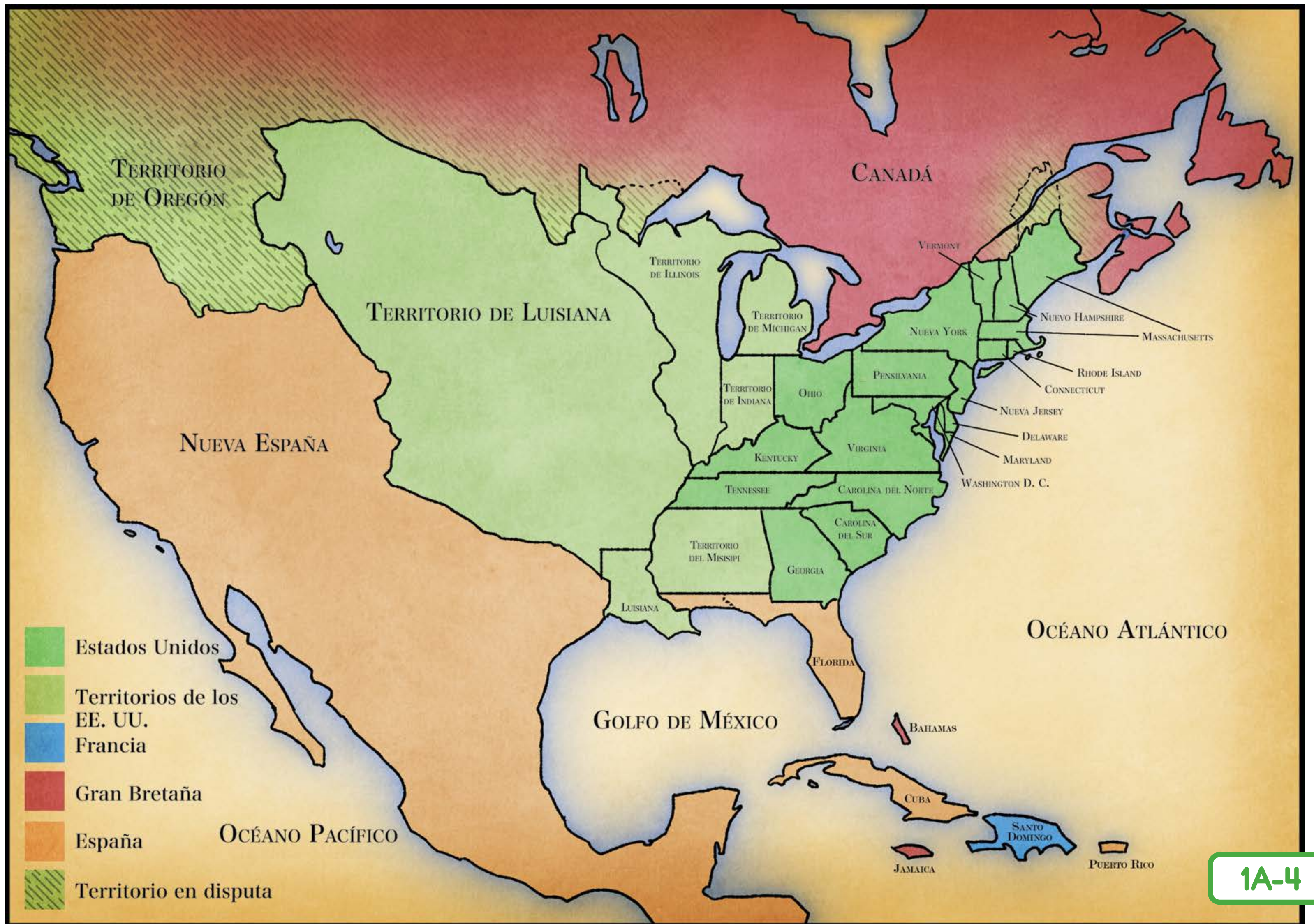




# WE THE PEOPLE

insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence  
and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution

Article I.  
Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.  
Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.  
No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.  
Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to the Number, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, and not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons. The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every thirty thousand, but each State shall have at least one Representative, and until such Enumeration shall be made, the State of New Hampshire shall have three, Rhode Island and Providence Plantations one, Connecticut five, New York six, New Jersey four, Pennsylvania seven, Delaware three, Maryland six, Virginia ten, North Carolina five, South Carolina five, and Georgia three.  
The Executive Authority thereof shall be vested in the President of the United States.  
The Senate shall have the sole Power of confirming and rejecting, by the Advice and Consent of the Senate, the Appointments and Receptions of Ambassadors, Ministers, Consuls, Judges, and all other Officers of the United States, who shall have the sole Power of making Treaties, provided they shall be entered into and ratified by the Senate and President of the United States.  
The Senate shall have the sole Power of organizing the Courts of the United States.

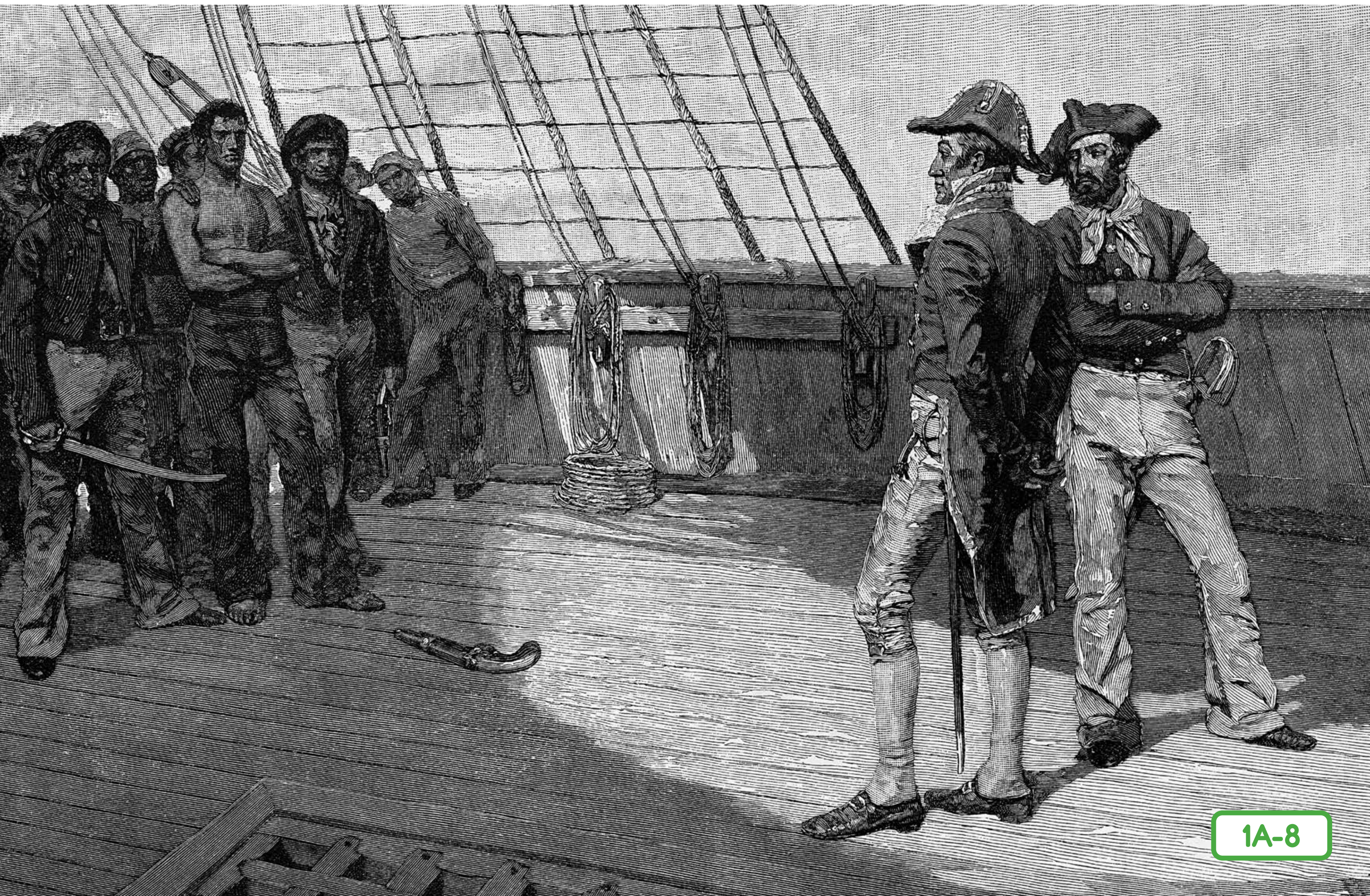




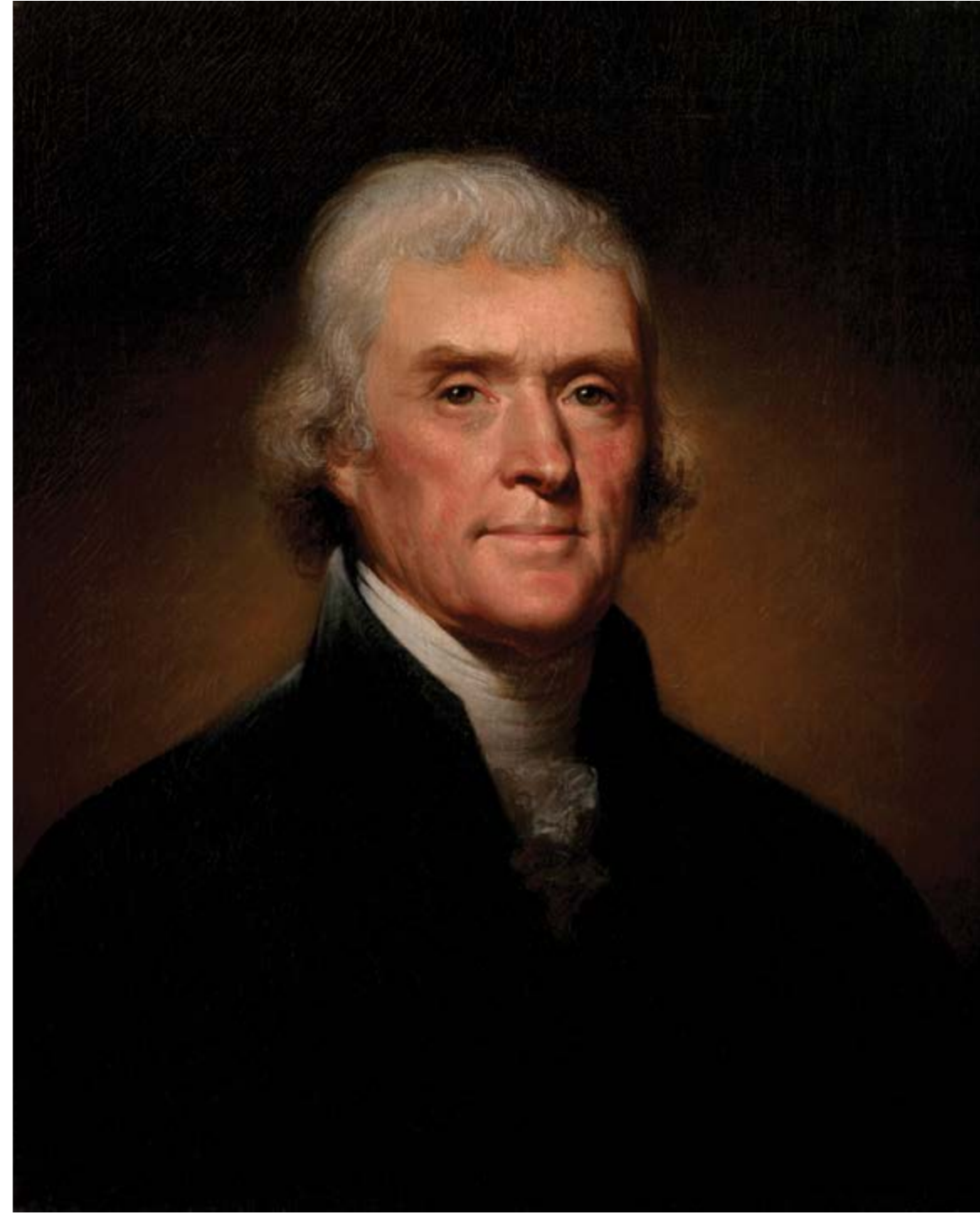
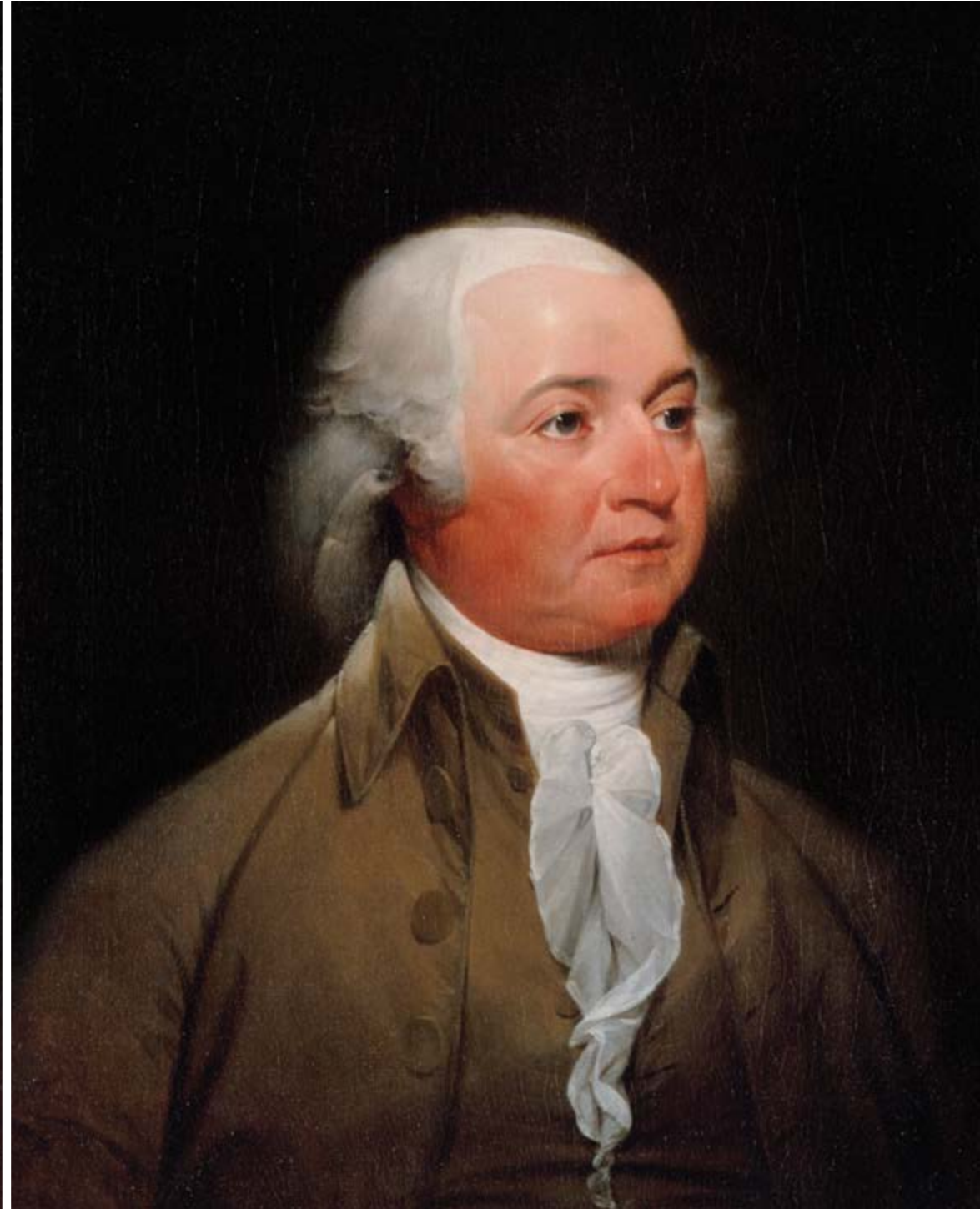










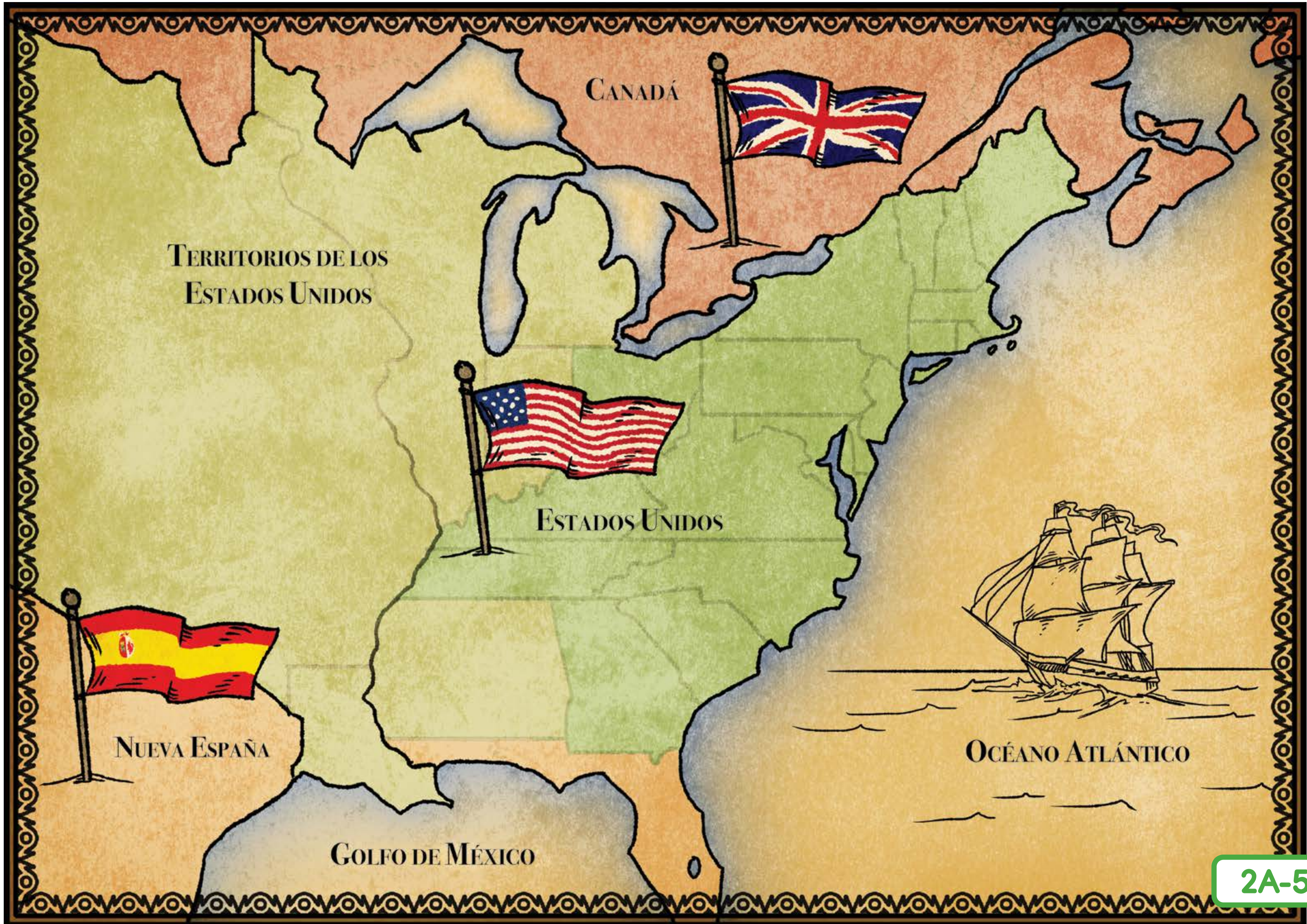










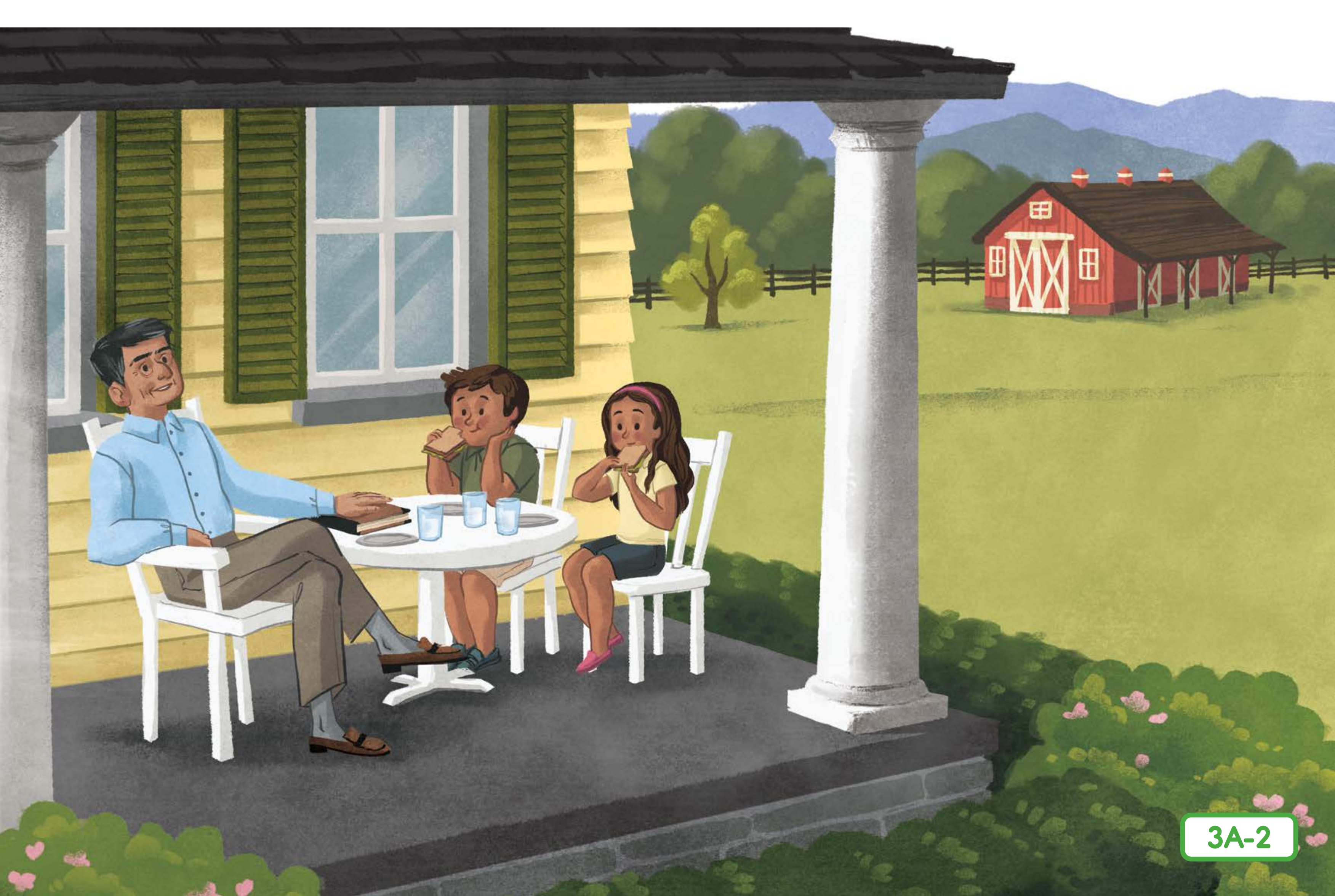












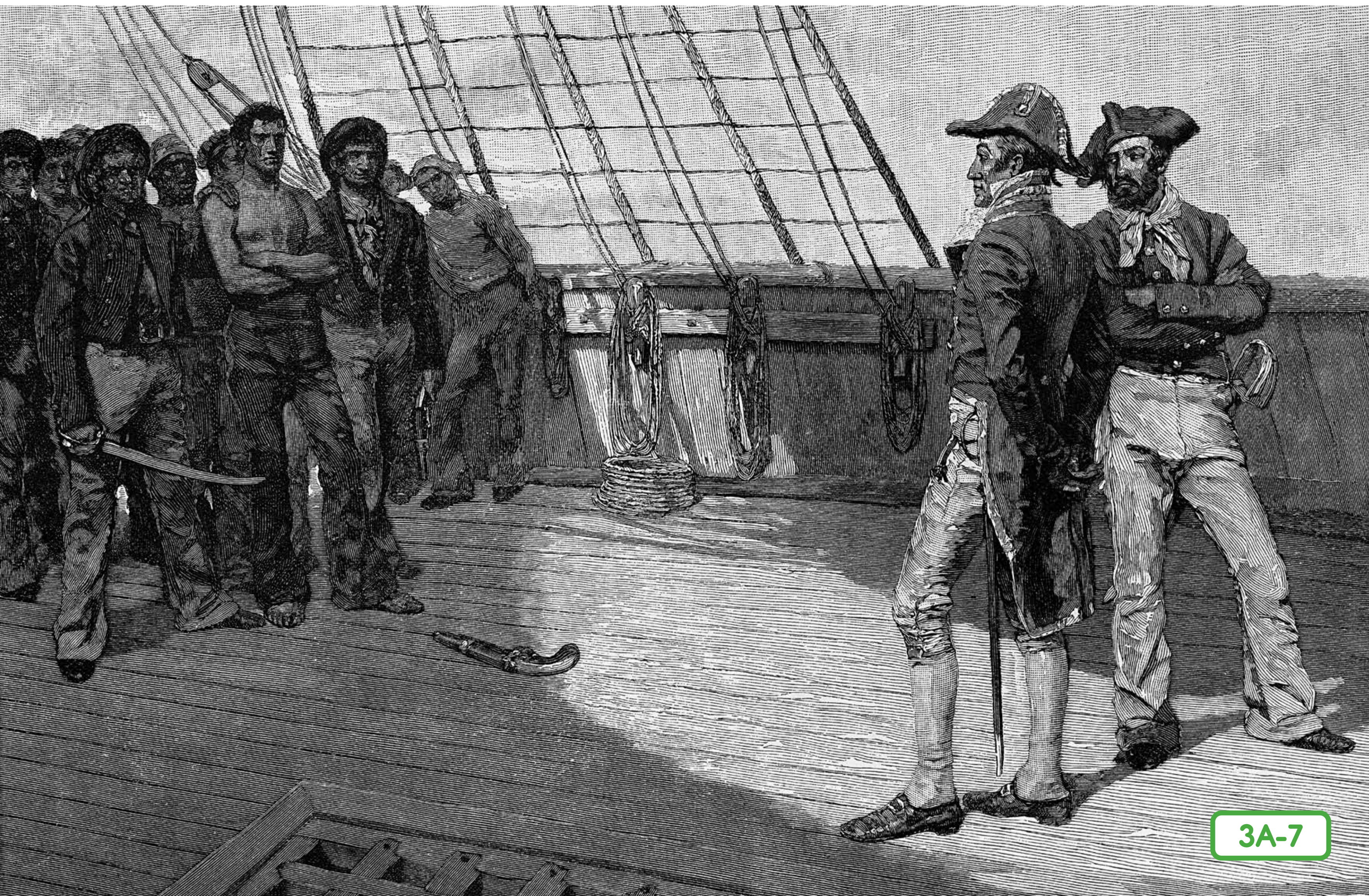










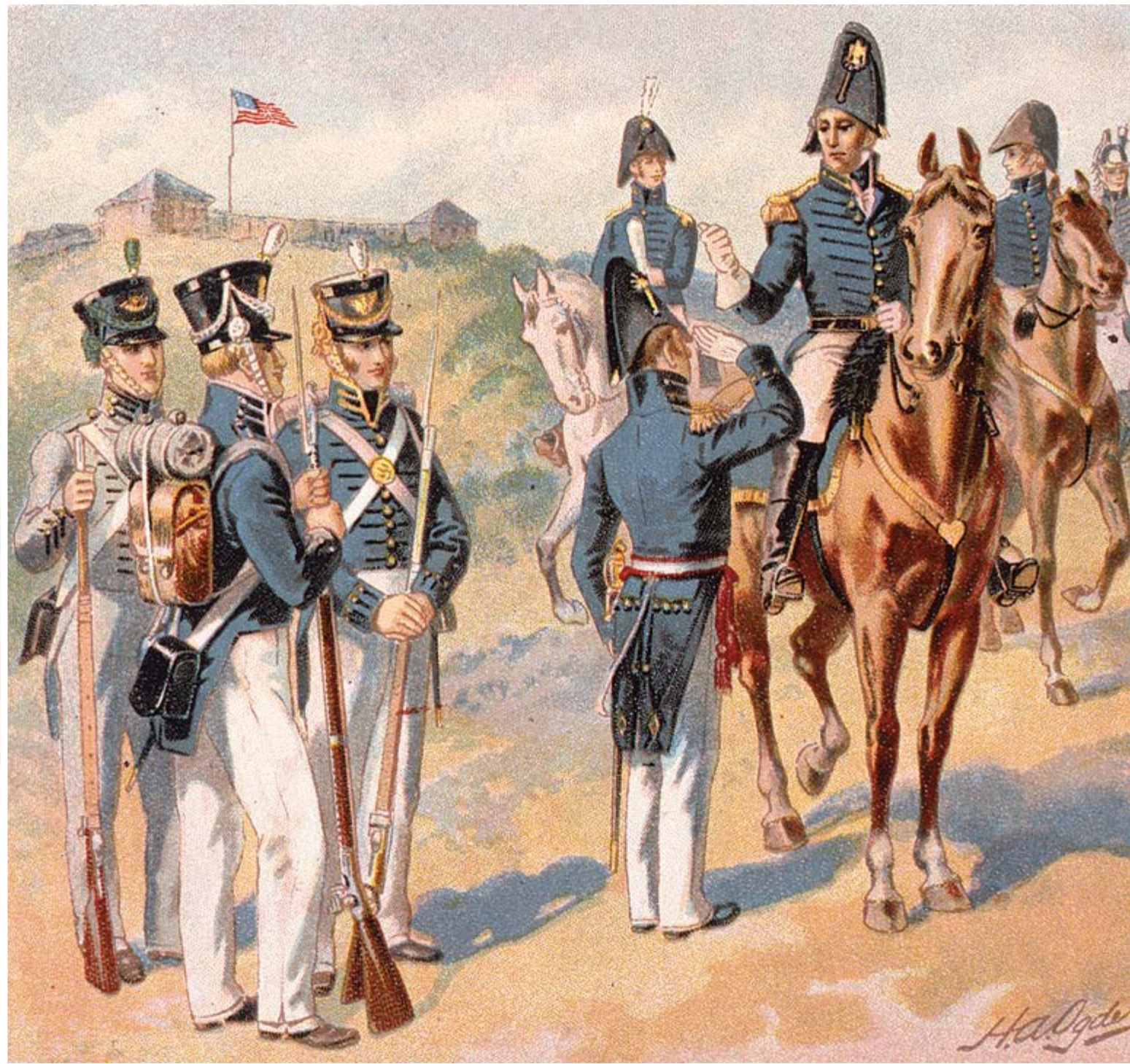

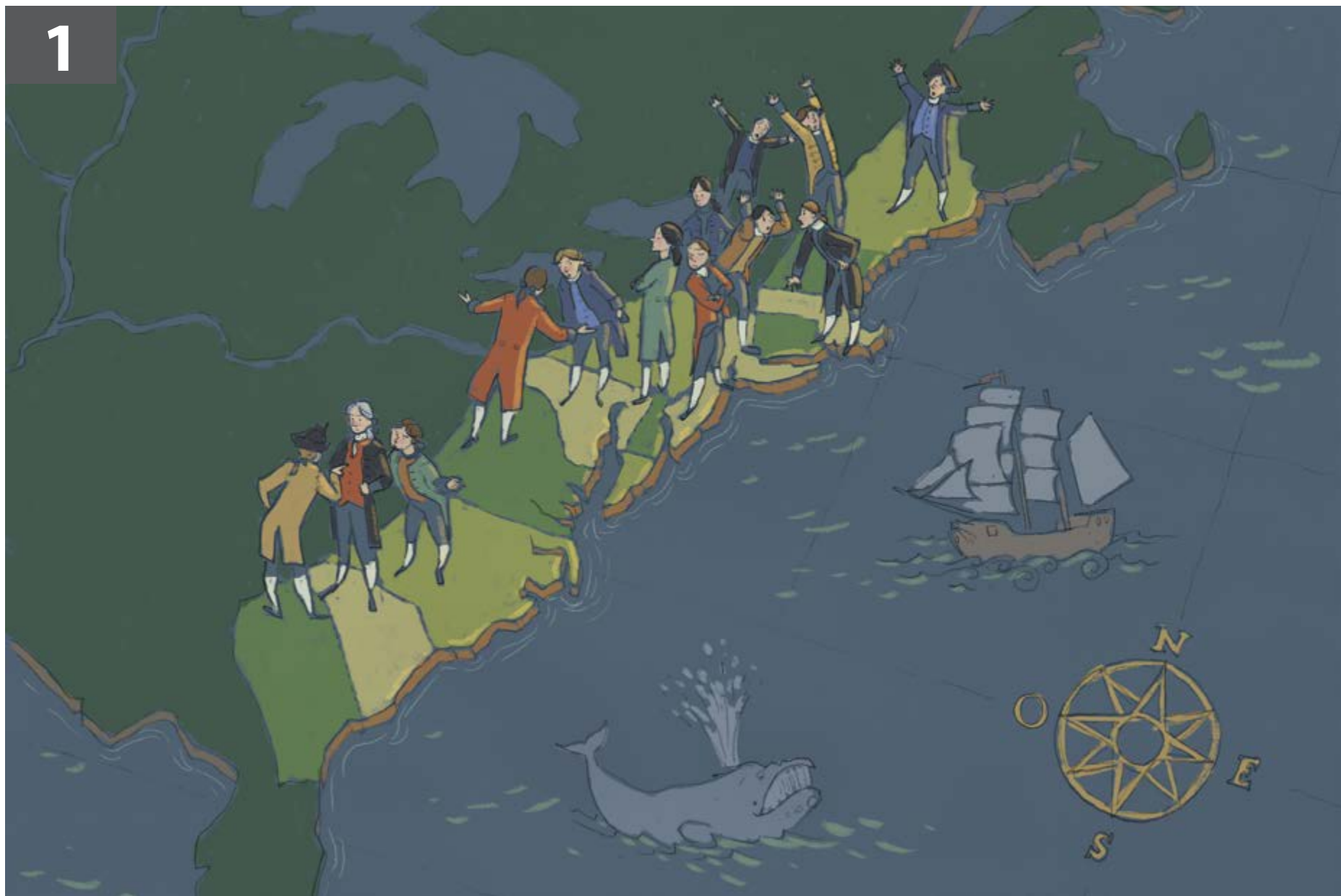


# Fuerte (Póster 1M)
